Press Release PIA passenger plane PK-8303 crashed in Karachi

Karachi, 22nd May 2020, Ill-fated Pakistan International Airlines (PIA) flight PK-8303 arriving from Lahore to Karachi with 91 passengers and 7 crew members went down in a residential area, just short of the Karachi airport today, Friday 22nd May 2020. 57 people have been killed till the last news reported. (Inna-lillahe-wa-inna-ilahe-rajoon).
